

Administrative Regulation 1331.1 Use of School Facilities By Traveling Youth Groups

Responsible Office: Office of Communications & Community Engagement

REGULATION

- 1. Traveling youth groups which request the use of school facilities for dormitory purposes may be permitted such use if:
 - a. There is no conflict with a school activity or schedule of maintenance.
 - b. The sponsoring organization is non-profit and non-sectarian.
 - c. The group is in Washoe County to participate in a community activity, or is visiting the community as a part of an educational tour.
 - d. The group carries adequate liability insurance.
 - e. The group has proper and adequate supervision.
 - f. The group agrees to pay for any damages done to school property or equipment.
 - g. The group agrees to pay for all overtime custodian services which must be rendered because of their use of facilities, plus any other necessary charges which are incurred by the school district due to the time or nature of the use.
