

# ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 6630 ARTS / HUMANITIES CREDIT – HIGH SCHOOL

**Responsible**: Department of Curriculum and Instruction

#### **PURPOSE**

In order to graduate from high school, students must earn a minimum of one (1) credit in the Arts/Humanities/Career & Technical Education. This administrative procedure shall define the ways in which a student may earn the necessary Arts/Humanities credit.

# **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Courses in the Washoe County School District Master Course File which meet the ARTS/HUMANITIES requirement are assigned an "AR" designation in the Course File. The following should be noted:
  - a. Some courses are listed more than once with each course number giving that course a different designation for example Creative Writing may be offered as an English course (1325/1326 which meets an Arts/Humanities requirement after four (4) English credits have been earned), an Arts/Humanities course (1323/1324), or an elective course (1327/1328), depending on the course number chosen.
  - b. World Language courses meet the Arts/Humanities requirement beginning in the third year of the same world language (levels 5-6 and above). Third, fourth, and fifth year online WL classes are also accepted.
  - c. After meeting the World History/World Geography requirement, a student may earn Arts/Humanities credit for taking the other course.
  - d. MOST courses in the 6000 series meet the Arts/Humanities credit.
  - e. MOST courses in the 10000 series meet the Arts/Humanities credit.
- 2. As per NAC 389.452 (revised February 2012) Arts and Humanities (NRS 385.080, 389.0185) the required course of study in arts and humanities may be one of the following:
  - a. Visual Arts
  - b. Music
  - c. Theater
  - d. Foreign Language, as set forth in NAC 389.570, in the third, fourth, and fifth years of instruction.
  - e. Other courses which are submitted to and approved by the state board of education.

# **DESIRED OUTCOMES**

1. This Administrative Procedure is designed to provide clarity and consistency as to which courses count towards meeting the graduation requirements for Arts/Humanities credit.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES & ASSOCIATED DOCUMENTS**

- 1. This Administrative Procedure reflects the goals of the District's Strategic Plan.
- 2. This Administrative Procedure aligns with Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 389, Examinations, Courses, Standards and Graduation, and specifically:
  - a. NAC 389.452 Arts and humanities
  - b. NAC 389.570 Foreign language: Fourth year

#### **REVIEW AND REPORTING**
