#### **PURPOSE**

This administrative procedure shall define what courses may be taken to meet the Health requirement for graduation.

### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. In order to graduate from high school a student must earn one-half (.5) credit in Health. This requirement may be met in one of the following ways:
  - a. Earn one-half (.5) credit in Health.
  - b. Successfully complete any five semesters in an HSROTC program.
  - c. Successfully complete both semesters of one of any of the following courses:

i.	10513/10514	Health Science I
ii.	10515/10516	Health Science II
iii.	10533/10534	Emergency Medical Services
iv.	10885/10886	Human Development I

2. It should be noted that there is no language in regulation that provides for exceptions to the graduation requirements based on religious beliefs; therefore, there is no exemption available for the Health requirement because of religious beliefs.
