#### **PURPOSE**

This list of approved courses for earning credit through a Credit by Exam (CBE) is associated with the Administrative Procedure for Recovering Credit through a Credit by Exam (6311) and is updated annually.

### **PROCEDURE**

## 1. Credit by Exam (CBE): Approved Courses

a. Credit for the following courses may be earned through the successful completion of a CBE. CBEs may include constructed response or essay items administered separately that must be scored by a teacher licensed in that subject area.
